You brought us into the net; you laid a crushing burden on our backs; you let men ride over our heads; we went through fire and through water; yet you have brought us out to a place of abundance.*

*Lord's Day, 3 April 2011*

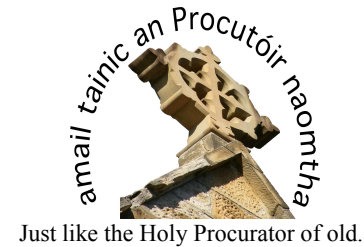
*Psalm 119:132*
