An opportunity to discredit any claims to be able to rely on You in times of trial

O my God, make them like whirling dust, like chaff before the wind. Fill their faces with shame, that they may seek your name, O LORD. Let them be put to shame and dismayed forever; let them perish in disgrace, that they may know that you alone, whose name is the LORD, are the Most High over all the earth.*

Lord, bless those who have been used by the Evil One to attack Your people, spreading dissension and discontent, causing us to take our eyes off You and concentrate on our past lives. All misery behind us, all glory ahead of us. Bring those who curse us into the Kingdom that we may welcome

them as brothers and sisters in the Lord.
