## *Tuesday, 11 September 2012*

Psalm 16:7-8

I bless the LORD who gives me counsel; in the night also my heart instructs me. (8) I have set the LORD always before me; because he is at my right hand, I shall not be shaken.

How can my heart instruct me in the night unless You give me counsel? How can You be at my right hand unless the Word is readily at hand? But if I am diligently staying in Your Word, I am prepared for all eventualities and will not be shaken.

Wednesday, 12 September 2012 Psalm 16:9-11

Therefore my heart is glad, and my whole being rejoices; my flesh also dwells secure. For you will not abandon my soul to Sheol, or let your holy one see corruption. You make known to me the path of life; in your presence there is fullness of joy; at your right hand are pleasures forevermore.

O, Lord, You must increase, I must decrease, for that is the path to fullness of joy, to the pleasures forevermore

at Your right hand. You shield me form the corruption that is all around, even though You have sent me to work among the filth that is the culture, You protect me and lead me. You will not let one, no not a single one of Your own be lost to the Evil One. Praise You, my Lord and Master.

## *Thursday, 13 September 2012 2 Corinthians 13:5*

Examine yourselves, to see whether you are in the faith. Test yourselves. Or do you not realize this about yourselves, that Jesus Christ is in you?--unless indeed you fail to meet the test!

Lord, it is a time of examen, a time to evaluate my walk with You in the light of Your Word. Friday, 14 September 2012 Psalm 17:1-5

You have tried my heart, you have visited me by night, you have tested me, and you will find nothing; I have purposed that my mouth will not transgress. With regard to the works of man, by the word of your lips I have avoided the ways of the violent. My steps have held fast to your paths; my feet have not slipped.

Lord, I acknowledged that my walk before You must

include a constant examination of all my motives and plans both before initiation and during all my actions. However, I am totally incapable of making such a transformation on my own. I need the guidance of the Spirit, the strength and power of the Spirit. Help me, Lord.

Saturday, 15 September 2012 Psalm 17:6-9

I call upon you, for you will answer me, O God; incline your ear to me; hear my words. Wondrously show your steadfast love, O Savior of those who seek refuge from their adversaries at your right hand. Keep me as the apple of your eye; hide me in the shadow of your wings, from the wicked who do me violence, my deadly enemies who surround me.

> Lord, my adversaries are not people who strive to oppose me but agents of the Evil One who attempt to blunt the power of Your mercy. If they can sway me away from following Your precepts, then they can point to me as another example of a hypocritical Christian. Lord, I must walk in holiness, in righteousness, in justice for Your Namesake, not mine. I must give You the glory in all circumstances.

Lord's Day, 16 September 2012 *Psalm 119:17* 

Deal bountifully with your servant, that I may live and keep your word.

You are dealing bountifully; You are my shepherd, what more could I ask? You have provided a life in the Kingdom, fully entitled as Your child. Therefore I am completely equipped to be Your servant, established as a citizen of Your realm, sent to carry Your message of hope and mercy into the Kingdom of Man. give me strength, wisdom and perseverance.
