Psalm 22:27-29

All the prosperous of the earth eat and worship; before him shall bow all who go down to the dust, even the one who could not keep himself alive

Wednesday, 14 November 2012 Psalm 22:30-31

Posterity shall serve him; it shall be told of the Lord to the coming generation; (31) they shall come and proclaim his righteousness to a people yet unborn, that he has done it.

The story of Your righteousness has been carried from

generation to generation and will continue until the Day comes. No matter how bleak the situation appears, You will be triumphant and Your righteousness will always be proclaimed. You are the Ruler of All Things!

Thursday, 15 November 2012 John 10:11, 14-17

I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep. ... I am the good shepherd. I know my own and my own know me, just as the Father knows me and I know the Father; and I lay down my life for the sheep. And I have other sheep that are not of this fold. I must bring them also, and they will listen to my voice. So there will be one flock, one shepherd. For this reason the Father loves me, because I lay down my life that I may take it up again.

> How precious and comforting that You spoke of me, recognizing Your plan for me, that I should be brought into Your flock in the fullness of time. One flock, one Shepherd--the foreshadowing of the one Lord, one Body, One Spirit, one Baptism yet to come.

Friday, 16 November 2012 Psalm 23:1-3

A Psalm of David. The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want. (2) He makes me lie down in green pastures. He leads me beside still waters. (3) He restores my soul. He leads me in paths of righteousness for his name's sake.

You are my shepherd, my rock and my deliverer. You provide a place of peace and provision, a haven from the evils which surround me. You restore and refresh when I am overcome with the turmoil and filth around me, You bring me into a way of righteous living to glorify Your Name. Praise You, my Lord, my Master, my Redeemer-Shepherd.

Saturday, 17 November 2012 Psalm 23:4-5

Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for you are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me. You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies; you anoint my head with oil; my cup overflows.

> Lord, that turmoil and filth around me certainly erupted yesterday as we suddenly found ourselves immersed in the tragedy of life without you. A young woman and child, victims of serious abuse, brought to us for protection and nurture. O, Lord, that we can be the conduits of Your love, bringing mother and child to know and love You. I also pray for their abuser, a broken and hurting man, that he will find You and the peace that comes only through You. My prayer is that this family will be reconciled to You and find that peace, the peace of this passage.

Lord's Day, 18 November 2012 *Psalm 119:89*
