Wednesday, 9 January 2013 Psalm 31:23-24

Deuteronomy 31:8 It is the LORD who goes before you. He will be with you; he will not leave you or forsake you. Do not fear or be dismayed."

Psalm 32:3-4

> Lord, help me, my strength is dried up. Not from heat but from a heart that is not beating effectively. Help me, Lord, and guide the doctors.

Lord's Day, 13 January 2013 Psalm 119:157-158

> My persecutors and adversaries are the little distractions, the urges to check e-mail, or let my mind wander from the task You have set before me.
