Wednesday, 20 February 2013 Psalm 35:22-25

Vindicate me, O LORD, my God, according to your righteousness, and let them not rejoice over me! Let them not say in their hearts, "Aha, our heart's desire!" Friday, 22 February 2013 Psalm 35:27-28

Let those who delight in my righteousness shout for joy and be glad and say evermore, "Great is the LORD, who delights in the welfare of his servant!" Then my tongue shall tell of your righteousness and of your praise all the day long.

> Lord, You do delight in my welfare, in those gifts of peace, righteousness and joy in the Holy Spirit that You bestow upon your obedient children. Let my tongue sing today of Your great love for me.

Saturday, 23 February 2013 Galatians 5:18

But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the law.
