There is Benjamin, the least of them, in the lead, the princes of Judah in their throng, the princes of Zebulun, the princes of Naphtali.

Kingdom in all its splendor. Your people will gather in Your sanctuary to praise and worship You. It will be the beginning of an everlasting time of righteousness, peace and joy.

Thursday, 7 November 2013 Psalm 68:28-31

Summon your power, O God, the power, O God, by which you have worked for us. Because of your temple at Jerusalem kings shall bear gifts to you. Rebuke the beasts that dwell among the reeds, the herd of bulls with the calves of the peoples. Trample underfoot those who lust after tribute; scatter the peoples who delight in war. Nobles shall come from Egypt; Cush shall hasten to stretch out her hands to God.

Justice will reign; peace will break out in the land; those who delight in evil will be scattered and all the nations of the earth will come to You in obeisance.

Friday, 8 November 2013 Psalm 68:32
