Psalm 97:7-10a

All worshipers of images are put to shame, who make their boast in worthless idols; worship him, all you gods! Zion hears and is glad, and the daughters of Judah rejoice, because of your judgments, O LORD. For you, O LORD, are most high over all the earth; you are exalted far above all gods. O you who love the LORD, hate evil!

That last sentence sounds like a statement that defines a test. Do I hate evil? Then I must love the Lord. Do I love the Lord, then I must hate evil? But I must not hate the evil doer, his deeds. My call is to demonstrate the love of the Lord, God Almighty and the power of the sacrifice of His Son, the Lord Jesus Christ.

He preserves the lives of his saints; he delivers them from the hand of the wicked. Light is sown for the righteous, and joy for the upright in heart. Rejoice in the LORD, O you righteous, and give thanks to his holy name!

You, O Lord, stand between me and the Evil One, You are my Shield and Buckler, Your Word is a light unto my path and a lamp unto my feet.

Wednesday, 11 June 2014 Revelation 22:17.20

The Spirit and the Bride say, "Come." And let the one who hears say, "Come." And let the one who is thirsty come; let the one who desires take the water of life without price. He who testifies to these things says, "Surely I am coming soon." Amen. Come, Lord Jesus!

Maranatha, come, Lord Jesus, come. Take Your own

out into Your Glory, surely You are coming soon. All creation cries, "Come, Lord Jesus, come.

Thursday, 12 June 2014 Psalm 98:1-3

A Psalm. Oh sing to the LORD a new song, for he has done marvelous things! His right hand and his holy arm have worked salvation for him. The LORD has made known his salvation; he has revealed his righteousness in the sight of the nations. He has remembered his steadfast love and faithfulness to the house of Israel.
