Psalm 104:31-35a

I will sing to the LORD as long as I live; I will sing praise to my God while I have being. May my meditation be pleasing to him, for I rejoice in the LORD. Lord, that my every thought, every utterance, every action will glorify You and bring those who don't know You to desire You.

Tuesday, 5 August 2014

Psalm 104:35b

Bless the LORD, O my soul! Praise the LORD!

That my mind and mouth, my very being would be filled with Your praises and that all creation would speak to me of Your glory.

Wednesday, 6 August 2014 2 Corinthians 1:19-21

For the Son of God, Jesus Christ, whom we proclaimed among you, Silvanus and Timothy and I, was not Yes and No, but in him it is always Yes. For all the promises of God find their Yes in him. That is why it is through him that we utter our Amen to God for his glory. And it is God who establishes us with you in Christ, and has anointed us.

All the promises of the Lord God Almighty come to fruition in You. All those great and precious promises that fall under Your statement that You will never leave nor forsake Your people. It is on the strength, the absolute inviability of that promise that I know in the depths of my heart that all things work together for good for those that love You and are

called according to Your purpose.

Thursday, 7 August 2014 Psalm 105:1-6

Oh give thanks to the LORD; call upon his name; make known his deeds among the peoples! Sing to him, sing praises to him; tell of all his wondrous works! Glory in his holy name; let the hearts of those who seek the LORD rejoice! Seek the LORD and his strength; seek his presence continually! Remember the wondrous works that he has done, his miracles, and the judgments he uttered, O offspring of Abraham, his servant, children of Jacob, his chosen ones!

Where is the modern day Song of Moses? Who has recounted the marvelous deeds of Lord for His Church as did Stephen before the Sanhedrin? Is there a prophet among us to write a great Psalm such as this one? Lord, cause the Holy Spirit to bring an eruption of praise that has not been seen for many years in this country.

Friday, 8 August 2014 Psalm 105:7-11

He is the LORD our God; his judgments are in all the earth. He remembers his covenant forever, the word that he commanded, for a thousand generations, the covenant that he made with Abraham, his sworn promise to Isaac, which he confirmed to Jacob as a statute, to Israel as an everlasting covenant, saying, "To you I will give the land of Canaan as your portion for an inheritance."

The everlasting covenant to Israel is the land of Canaan; the everlasting covenant to Your Church is the Kingdom of Heaven. Even as a remnant dwells in a portion of the land of Canaan today; Your Church dwells in a portion of the Kingdom of Heaven. But oh, the glories before us as You call Your own to You.

Saturday, 9 August 2014 Psalm 105:12-25

When they were few in number, of little account, and sojourners in it, wandering from nation to nation, from one kingdom to another people, he allowed no one to oppress them; he rebuked kings on their account, saying, "Touch not my anointed ones, do my prophets no harm!" When he summoned a famine on the land and broke all supply of bread, he had sent a man ahead of them, Joseph, who was sold as a slave. His feet were hurt with fetters; his neck was put in a collar of iron; until what he had said came to pass, the word of the LORD tested him. The king sent and released him; the ruler of the peoples set him free; he made him lord of his house and ruler of all his possessions, to bind his princes at his pleasure and to teach his elders wisdom. Then Israel came to Egypt; Jacob sojourned in the land of Ham. And the LORD made his people very fruitful and made them stronger than their foes. He turned their hearts to hate his people, to deal craftily with his servants.

> Lord, You watched over Israel and You continue to do so. Though beset by famine, You had set a savior in place to rescue them and caused them to grow into a mighty people.

> You have watched over Your Church and You continue to do so. Beset not by famine of the body but by famine of the spirit, You have set a Savior in place to rescue us and to cause us to grow into a mighty people in Your Name.

Lord's Day, 10 August 2014 Psalm 119:99-100

I have more understanding than all my teachers, for your testimonies are my meditation. I understand more than the aged, for I keep your precepts.

I'm not there Lord for you have blessed me with teachers whose way of life is shaped by Your Word and Your Law. You use them to give me understanding and wisdom. Thank You, Lord. Bless them and grant them complete peace and the joy of the Kingdom in every aspect of their lives.
