Psalm 111:2-6

Tuesday, 30 September 2014

Psalm 111:7-10

The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom; all those who practice it have a good understanding. His praise endures forever!

Friday, 3 October 2014 Psalm 112:2-8
