Philippians 2:5-11

Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours in Christ Jesus, who, though he was in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, but emptied himself, by taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men. And being found in human form, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross. Therefore God has highly exalted him and bestowed on him the name that is above every name, so that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

The Man of Humility, not the humility of man, always flawed, but a Humility that only one who is truly sinless could achieve. It is right and proper that the Day will come when every tongue confesses You are Lord.

Tuesday, 28 October 2014

Psalms 117:1-2

Matthew 21:42-46

Therefore I tell you, the kingdom of God will be taken away from you and given to a people producing its fruits. And although they were seeking to arrest him, they feared the crowds, because they held him to be a prophet.
