Twelve Questions That Could Change Your Church

Is Yours a Healthy, Growing Church?

In Ephesians 4.11-16, the Apostle Paul shows us how to think about healthy, growing churches, and how they get that way:

And he gave the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, the pastors and teachers, to equip the saints for the work of ministry, for building up the body of Christ, until we all attain to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to mature manhood, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ...

The twelve questions that follow allow you the opportunity to examine your church in the light of Paul's insights. In each case, render a low and a high score, reflecting how you think about your church in each category as to its *worst* and its *best* rating. Your answer to each question will give you a "window" on your church in each of twelve areas. Healthy, growing churches strive to narrow that window and to move it further along to the right in each category. By regular assessment, faithful prayer, careful planning, and diligent execution, churches can grow in the ways Paul describes, faithfully increasing in unity and maturity.
