## Psalm 139:13-16

#### Wednesday, 18 February 2015 Psalm 139:17-18

## Thursday, 19 February 2015 Psalm 139:19-22

And do I not loathe those who rise up against you? I hate them with complete hatred; I count them my enemies.

## *Friday, 20 February 2015 Psalm 139:23-24*
