Matthew 5:20

For I tell you, unless your righteousness exceeds that of the scribes and Pharisees, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven. Legalistic obedience versus a Romans 12:1-2

transformation that that creates a John 14:15 obedience based on love in me.

Thursday, 5 May 2016

Matthew 5:21

"You have heard that it was said to those of old, 'You shall not murder; and whoever murders will be liable to judgment.'

I am convicted by Matthew 5:19 that the penalty is severe if I teach others to excuse their disobedience. How much more severe will it be if I refuse to warn them at all? Ezekiel 3:18 If I say to the wicked, 'You shall surely die,' and you give him no warning, nor speak to warn the wicked from his wicked way, in order to save his life, that wicked person shall die for his iniquity, but his blood I will require at your hand.

Do not 61,000,000 murders on the alter of Moloch, the god of choice, cry out for me to raise my voice in protest? Does not the complacency of the Church come under the judgment of Ezekiel 3:18? The screams of tortured infants should prevent any of us from sleeping at night, but we are callused and complacent.

How will I answer when called before the Great Throne to answer for my use of the talent assigned to me? There will be no "Well done" for me!

Friday, 6 May 2016

Matthew 5:22

But I say to you that everyone who is angry with his brother will be liable to judgment; whoever insults his brother will be liable to the council; and whoever says, 'You fool!' will be liable to the hell of fire.

> Just to be angry with another person or even to point out that he is a fool? Come on! How can our Lord equate that with murder?

I believe that the answer is simple. When I do so, I scorn the *Imago Dei* of my fellow man, I refuse to recognize that he is made in the image of God. A blatant violation of the command to love my neighbor.

Saturday, 7 May 2016 Matthew 5:23-24

So if you are offering your gift at the altar and there remember that your brother has something against you, leave your gift there before the altar and go. First be reconciled to your brother, and then come and offer your gift.

How can I, even why should I expect that He can be mollified by a gift that is offered by an unrepentant heart? If I have offended another bearer of His image, and I am so insensitive to His holiness that I don't realize it--I have amends to make beginning with my brother. I must humbly approach my fellow human being and petition his forgiveness. Is this not proof that I have taken Matthew 5:3-11 to heart and seek to reorder my life according to this guide?

Lord's Day, 8 May 2016 Psalm 119:145 With my whole heart I cry; answer me, O LORD! I will keep your statutes.

The problem is to cry out to You. I in my stubbornness and self-will continue to plow ahead with no thought of turning to You until I have made a complete botch. Lord, teach me at the beginning to turn to You, even before I commit. Help me, Lord.
