"Keep the whole commandment" Lord, don't You think that's a bit over the top, excessively strict? Now, look, I keep most of the commandments, well, sometimes I might shade one or two a tad but that's little stuff. Right? OK, so that clerk gave me the wrong change, but come on, less that a cup of coffee at MacDonalds. What do You mean, restitution? Apologize to that clerk and return four times the amount? I'm not Zacchaeus! You told him that salvation came to his house that day? You must mean that obedience vs. disobedience is an all or nothing proposition. Forgive me, Lord, for my greed and willfulness.

Tuesday, 20 September 2016 Deuteronomy 11:7-9 [3] For your eyes have seen all the great work of the LORD that he did. "You shall therefore keep the whole commandment that I command you today, that you may be strong, and go in and take possession of the land that you are going over to possess, and that you may live long in the land that the LORD swore to your fathers to give to them and to their offspring, a land flowing with milk and honey. "Take possession, live long in a land flowing with milk and honey." Hummm, might that not be a description of life in the Kingdom of Heaven in the here and now? A land of

righteousness, peace and joy in the Holy Spirit? Continue to guide me, Lord. Thank You for the gift of the Comforter to lead me along the King's Highway.

Wednesday, 21 September 2016 Deuteronomy 11:18-22 [1] "So commit yourselves wholeheartedly to these words of mine. Tie them to your hands and wear them on your forehead as reminders. Teach them to your children. Talk about them when you are at home and when you are on the road, when you are going to bed and when you are getting up. Write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates, so that as long as the sky remains above the earth, you and your children may flourish in the land the LORD swore to give your ancestors. "Be careful to obey all these commands I am giving you. Show love to the LORD your God by walking in His ways and holding tightly to Him.

There's that pesky word again. Commit! It has several definitions, some positive with the connotations of entrust or dedicate; some have negative such as to perpetuate a crime but all have a common thread. They are all or nothing. Rather ridiculous to think about walking into a bank and announcing that you might be there to pull off a robbery. Equally ridiculous to think that you can sort of obey the LORD, God the Almighty. A halfhearted commitment is no commitment at all.

Write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates, so that as long as the sky remains above the earth, you and your children may flourish in the land the LORD swore to give your ancestors. "Be careful to obey all these commands I am giving you. Show love to the LORD your God by walking in His ways and holding tightly to Him.

The first deal with my need to have visual reminders and to have continuous statements to my Personal Mission Field. "Be careful to obey all these commands I am giving you. Show love to the LORD your God by walking in His ways and holding tightly to Him. Teach them to your children (and everyone else). Does my conversation drip praise to the LORD, God the Almighty as a matter of course? Do I acknowledge His presence and intervention in all aspects of my life?

My transformation is a work in process.
