Monday, 7 March 2016 Isaiah 51:6

Look up to the skies above, and gaze down on the earth below. For the skies will disappear like smoke, and the earth will wear out like a piece of clothing. The people of the earth will die like flies, but My salvation lasts forever. My righteous rule will never end! [NLT]

Tuesday, 8 March 2016

Psalms 89:14

Wednesday, 9 March 2016 Jeremiah 23:5-6

"For the time is coming," says the LORD, "when I will raise up a righteous descendant from King David's line. He will be a King who rules with wisdom. He will do what is just and right throughout the land. And this will be His name: 'The LORD Is Our Righteousness.' In that day Judah will be saved, and Israel will live in safety. [NLT]

Yes, I know Jeremiah writes regarding the coming of my Lord and Savior, but wouldn't it be an incredible

blessing to have a candidate for office who was seeking to exercise the responsibilities of the office upon the righteousness of the LORD, God the Almighty? Maybe I should be using this as a standard to evaluate my votes next November?

Thursday, 10 March 2016

1 Corinthians 1:30-31

And because of him you are in Christ Jesus, who became to us wisdom from God, righteousness and sanctification and redemption, so that, as it is written, "Let the one who boasts, boast in the Lord."

Christ Jesus, God Incarnate, the LORD, God the Almighty who became man and dwelt among us, provides the window into the righteousness and justice that I need to conduct all facets of my life in a way that glorifies Him. Plus, I have no excuse for not knowing. Romans 1:20 tells me that His invisible qualities--His eternal power and divine nature are clearly displayed throughout His Creation.

Friday, 11 March 2016

Genesis 15:6

And he believed the LORD, and he counted it to him as righteousness.

And now to the crux of the matter. Just as Abraham believed (had faith, trusted, committed, obeyed) and it was counted to him as righteousness, so must I. He didn't walk perfectly, a couple of instances where he did not trust Yahweh for his safety and lied about his relationship with Sarah come to mind, yet he is counted among the LORD, God the Almighty's faithful. Lord, lead me into a life of faithfulness to You and Your Word. Forgive me for those instances where I allow doubt and anxiety to consume my peace.

Saturday, 12 March 2016

Romans 4:5-6

And to the one who does not work but believes in him who justifies the ungodly, his faith is counted as righteousness, just as David also speaks of the blessing of the one to whom God counts righteousness apart from works:

Catch that--it is faith (trust, belief, commit, obey) that makes me righteous in His eyes. It is not all the things I do in His Name, or the number of times I preach or the books I write, or the consistency with which I read the Bible, or the elaborateness of my prayers, or on and on. No, it is do I trust Him, do I believe His Word, is He Lord and Master of my life?

Lord's Day, 13 March 2016 Psalm 119:83

For I have become like a wineskin in the smoke, yet I have not forgotten your statutes.

Yes, Lord, I feel like I am in a swirling cloud of smoke without a clear vision of purpose and direction. Help me to see clearly where Your will is for me and help me to not be diverted.
